Clothing Requests:

We go out every day, regardless of weather. Please make sure your child has winter boots, extra mittens, snow pants, and a warm jacket. As the weather changes the extra clothing should also be changed. Please also label **ALL** of your children's clothing.

General Health Info:

It is cold and flu season. Please make sure that your child washes their hands upon arrival to school to stop the spread of germs. Also, if your child has a temperature over 100.5, is vomiting, or is experiencing diarrhea he/she may return to school 24 hours after these symptoms have stopped.



Dear Families:

February was such a short month! We focused on literacy and a lot of outdoor learning. We read the books "Polar Bear, Polar Bear, What do you Hear," and "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do you See?" The children each got to participate in the stories through puppets and listening for their part. They enjoyed the hands on interaction during story time. We extended our stories by creating some projects for the classroom, such as masks and window art. There has been an increasing interest in building forts, so we created an area in the classroom to find different ways to build forts. We used boxes, blankets, boards, and rest mats to create different types of forts. This activity helped strengthened our teamwork abilities because it takes a lot of patience to work with each other to come up with a solution that works for everyone. The weather was beautiful and we were able to take several different materials outside to explore. One of our favorites was using spray bottles with colored water. The spray bottles helped to strengthen our fine motor (small muscle) skills while creating beautiful art in the snow. We extended on this by making snow volcanoes using baking soda and vinegar. It was exciting to see the snow volcanoes come to life!

Important Reminders
